

MUSIC IN A SCORE

28. Look at this music and then answer the questions below.

Allegro

- 3 quavers (8th notes) per bar

c. What is the highest note in the music? [1]

d. Which bar does **not** contain **any** notes from the tonic triad? The key is E major. [1]

e. Which minor key uses this key signature? [1]
